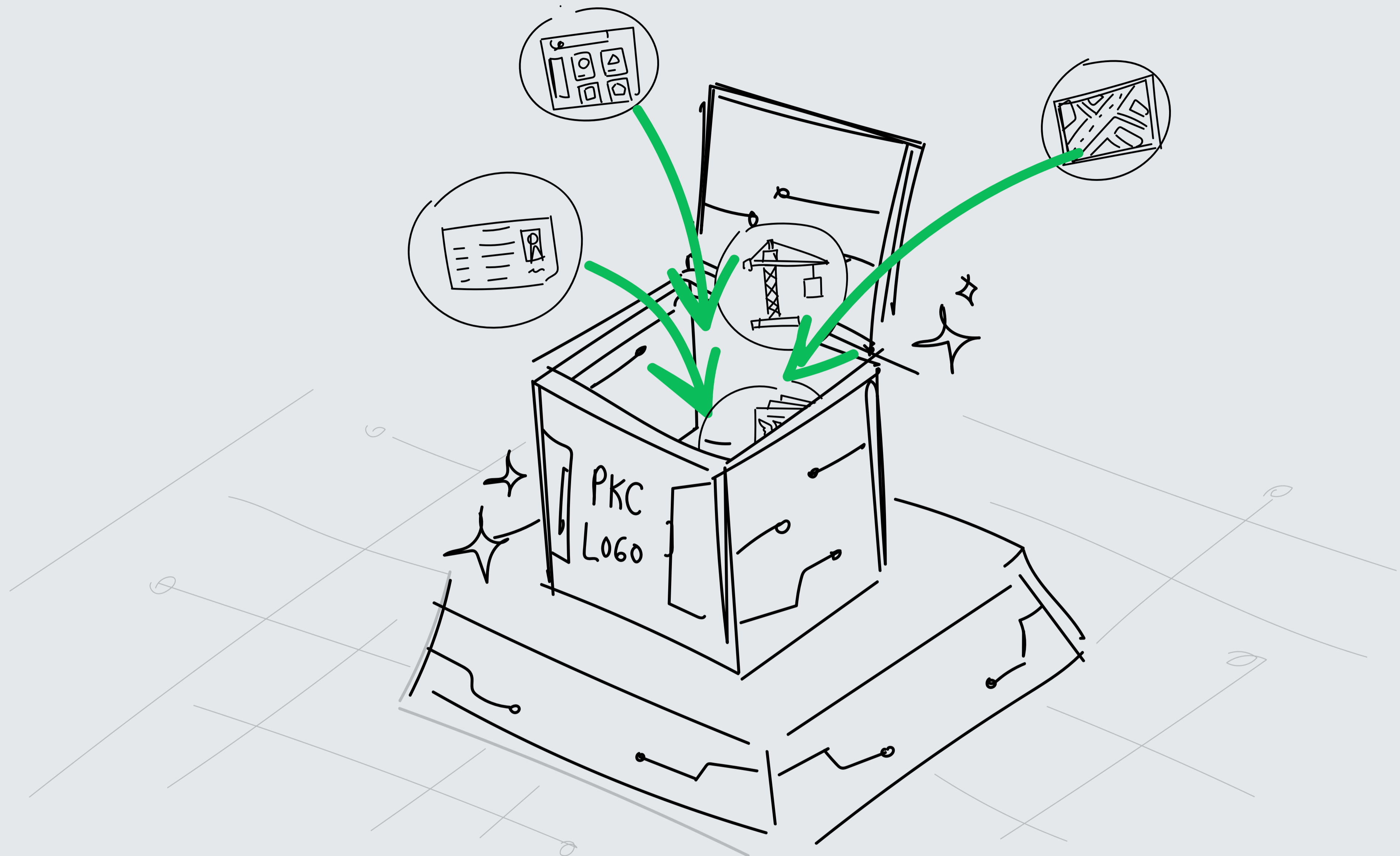

Icons in bubbles represent data items of these 3 classification:

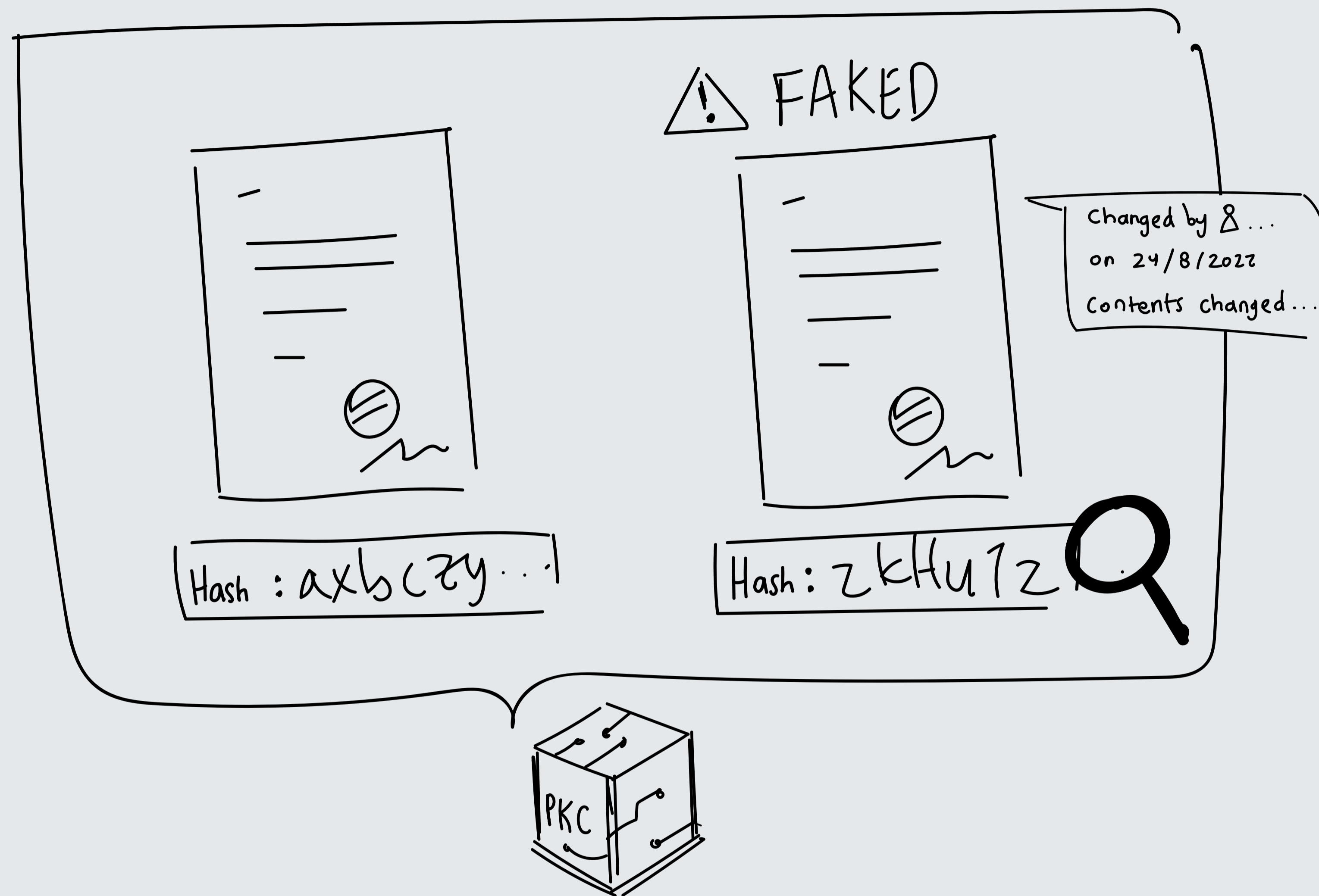
1. e-ID (identities of citizens)

All the data icons (in previous screen) get into PKC box.

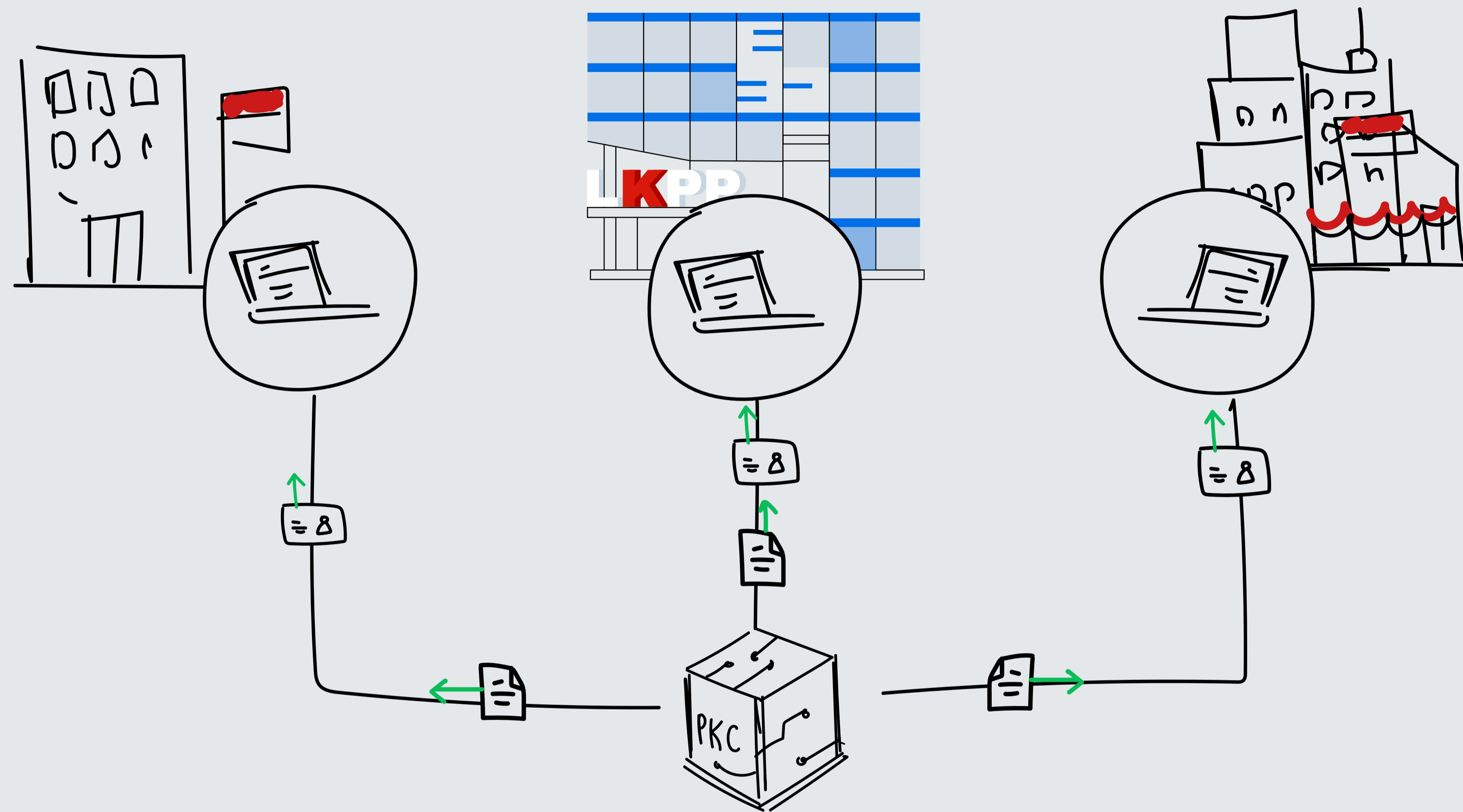

2 documents looks exactly same, but turns out the 2nd has different hash.

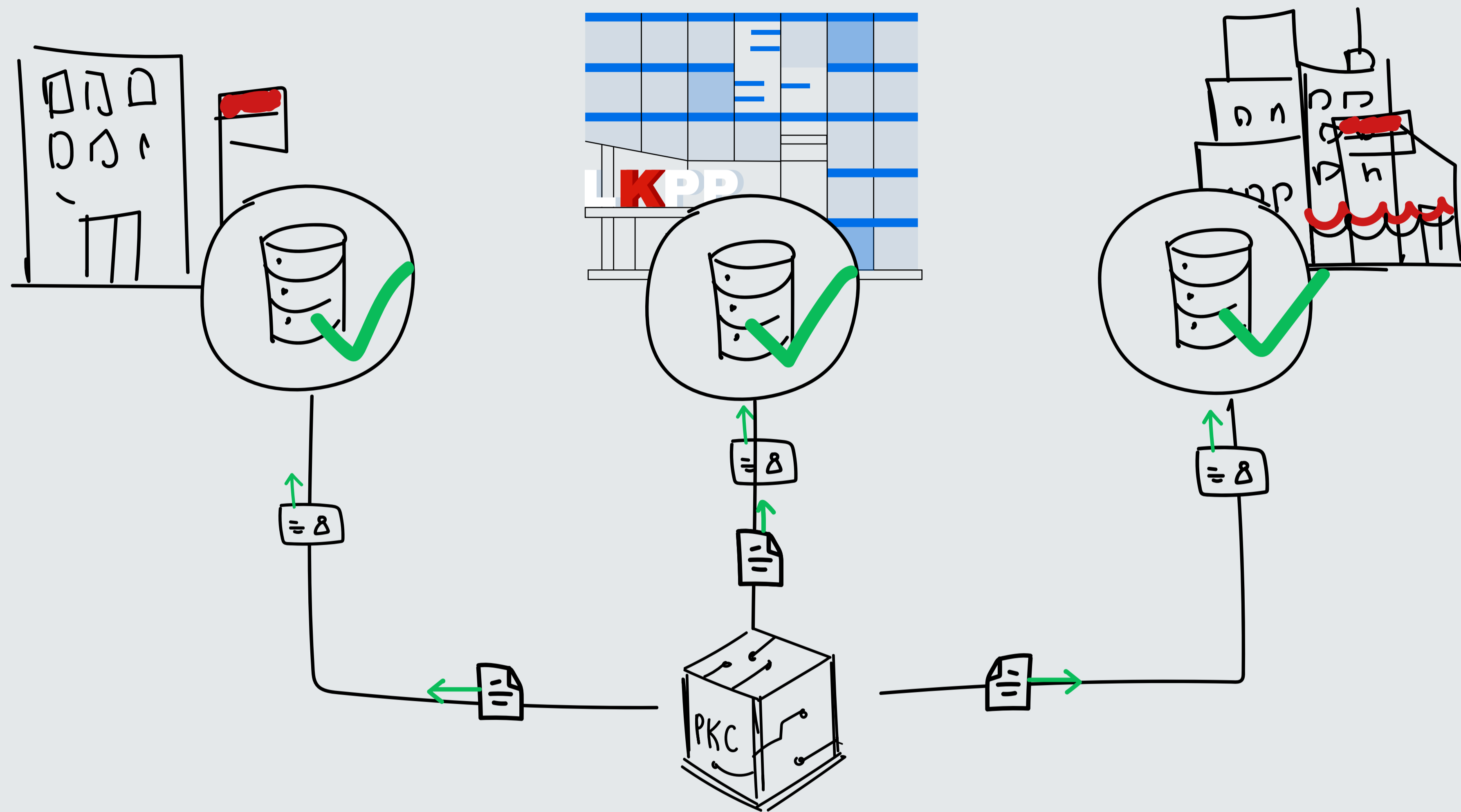
That 2nd document is faked, and PKC records who changed that document content, when was the change happened, and what content was changed.



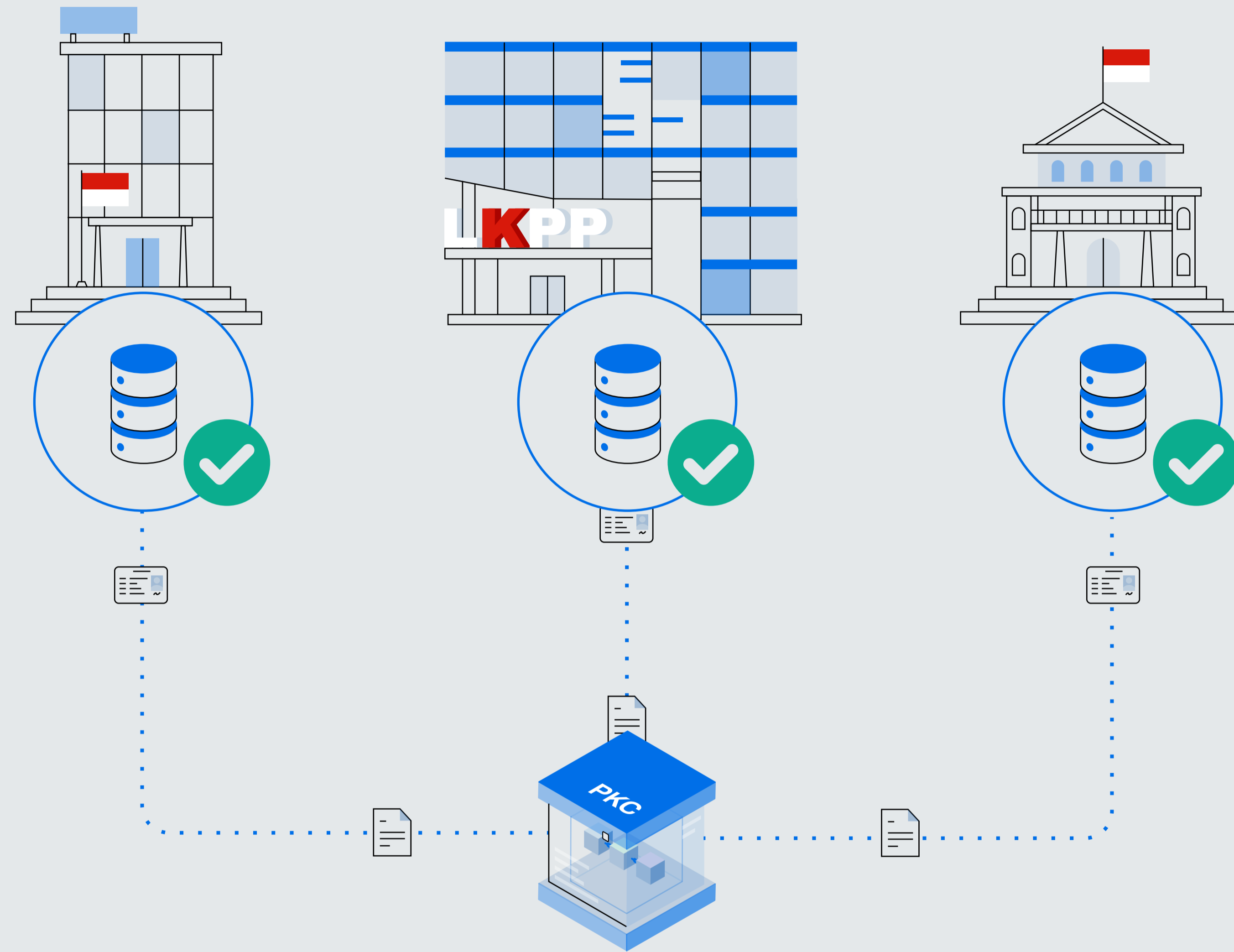
and web-enabled observability
